Endura Products, manufacturers of entry door component systems, has partnered with several door manufacturers in recent years to create door systems that meet Florida building code standards for structural wind loads, air and water infiltration, and impact resistance. Among their products that have passed Dade County testing is the Ultimate Astragal, shown at this year's International Builders' Show. Some features include a patented three-point sealing system and a flush bolt with a durable "floating seal". An optional Hurricane Astragal Kit is also available, which includes a 24-inch steel reinforced flush bolt and retainers for the header and sill. With the Hurricane Kit, the Ultimate Astragal has reached structural wind loads of DP50, ASTM E 330 performances of 75 PSF and large missile impact resistance. The Z-Series Entry Door Sill, also displayed at the show, has tested successfully for Florida wind zone certifications with Nan-Ya fiberglass and Jeld-Wen Challenge doors. Endura's customers have used these results to get Florida certification for their door units and satisfy market demand for these products.
