Endura shows how Mull Boots prevent water damage and callbacks at the Pacific Coast Builders' Conference.

Injection-molded with easy-to-paint plastic, the Endura Mull Boot comes in five sizes and is designed to enhance sidelite applications of the Endura Z-Series™ family of sills.
