Endura enhances sill performance with the introduction of a new Nailing Fin and Sill Pan.

Endura Products, Inc. will debut two new door system accessories at the Pacific Coast Builders' Conference in June 2004. The new Sill Extender Mounted Nailing Fin and the Door Sill Pan will provide builders with two more ways to ease installation, protect the entire door unit and add value to the home.

The new PVC nailing fin system is a unique performance enhancer for entry doors. The Endura designed, engineered and tested nailing fin engages the front lip of the threshold and allows the sill unit to be secured to the frame of the house for added strength, improved performance and no callbacks. It can be cut to fit any sill length and blocks the gaps caused by uneven rough openings and improper caulking beneath the sill.

An additional enhancement to door installation, the new PVC sill pan protects the frame from rot and warping, and reduces the risk of water damage to interior carpets and hardwood floors. The sill pan is mounted in the rough opening and provides a final impervious barrier to moisture under the threshold, eliminating the need for caulking.

Both accessories, along with six other new and innovative products, will be shown at PCBC, booth #5425, in San Francisco, CA, June 15-18, 2004.
